Schedule: Show Starts at **8:00AM** with the Combined JR/SR Doe Show in Ring 1 and Showmanship in Ring 2. The Double Ring Combined JR/SR Doe Shows will be followed by the Double Ring Junior Doe Show.

Directions: The State Show will be held at the Centre County Fairgrounds in Centre Hall. Centre Hall is located approximately 12 miles from State College, PA on Route 144. The fairgrounds are located in the center of town. Watch for Grange Fair entrance signs. Use gates 2 and 3.

Venders are asked to donate one item to the raffle table.

1. **SHOW ORDER:** This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Associates and its rules shall govern. The Combined JR/SR Doe Shows and the Junior Doe shows **are** separately sanctioned. **The Combined JR/SR Doe Show will start in Ring 1** at 8:00AM. Show order will be Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Saanen, Nubian, AOP, Toggenburg, and Recorded Grade. **The Combined JR/SR Doe Show will start in Ring 2** following showmanship with the show order of Alpines, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Saanen, Nubian, AOP, Toggenburg, and Recorded Grade. **The order of the show is subject to change.**

The Junior Doe Show will be held following the Combined JR/SR Doe Shows. Show order will be Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, AOP, and Recorded Grade. After Alpines are finished in Ring 1, they will move to Ring 2 and follow the above show order. **The order of the show is subject to change.**

2. **CHECK IN:** Saturday before **8:00 AM**.

3. **ANIMAL REGISTRATION:** The base date for computing the age of the does entered is June 10, 2017. All animals must be accompanied by registration, recordation or stamped ADGA duplicate application for animals under 6 months of age. All papers must be shown to the show secretary prior to show. No copies, telephone calls or telegrams will be accepted in lieu of original papers.

4. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** Current health papers must accompany animals originating from your home state. All animals must be listed on an official AAI-13 Health Certificate. **ALL ANIMALS MUST BE CHECKED BEFORE UNLOADING. DO NOT UNLOAD UNTIL SHOW COMMITTEE OR VET CHECKS YOUR ANIMALS!** Animals showing signs of infectious or contagious disease (including soremouth pinkeye, abscesses, ringworm) will be barred from the show. The decision of the Show Committee and appointed Vet will be final.

5. **PEN FEES:** Instead of pen fees you are required to clean your own pens. If you do not want to clean your own pens then a **\$10 per pen** fee will be charged. You only need to place bedding in the aisle. No refrigerators or cooking devices in the barns for fire safety reasons.

6. **ENTRY FEES:**

PDGA members: Entries postmarked by May 30: \$8.00 double ring and \$4.00 single ring.

Non-members: Entries postmarked by May 30: \$10.00 double ring and \$5.00 single ring.

PDGA Members and Non-members: Entries postmarked after May 30: \$12.00 double ring and \$6.00 single ring.

There will be a \$2.00 entry fee for Miss Pennsylvania accepted until time of judging.

7. **NO SMOKING:** No smoking allowed in or around Barn Area and Show Ring.
DOGS: Dogs should be restrained and kept out of the goat barns and show ring.
BICYCLES: No bicycles, roller blades or skateboards allowed in or around the Barn Area and Show Ring.
8. **FOOD:** A food stand will be provided.
9. **EXCLUSION OF RESPONSIBILITY:** The PDGA will not be responsible for any accidents or loss to persons, property, or animals while on the fairgrounds.
10. **RV CAMPERS: \$30 per night (payable to PDGA)**

* **Miss Pennsylvania: \$2.00 Entry Fee.** All animals entered in this class must be bred and owned by a Pennsylvania resident, as stated on the papers, but not necessarily by the same person. A doe may win the title only once. The previous year's winner awards the prize.
