1. **SHOW ORDER:** This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Associates and **ADGA RULES SHALL GOVERN**. The Combined JR/SR Doe Shows and the Junior Doe Shows **are** separately sanctioned. **The Combined JR/SR Doe Show will start in Ring 1** following showmanship, and the show order will be (A) Alpine, (L) LaMancha, (D) Nigerian Dwarf, (N) Nubian, (O) Oberhasli, (S) Saanen, (T) Toggenburg, and (R) Recorded Grade. After Alpines are judged in Ring 1, they will move to Ring 2 and follow the above show order. **The order of the show is subject to change.**

**The Junior Doe Show** will be held following the Combined JR/SR Doe Shows. Show order will be (A) Alpine, (L) LaMancha, (D) Nigerian Dwarf, (N) Nubian, (O) Oberhasli, (S) Saanen, (T) Toggenburg, and (R) Recorded Grade. After Alpines are judged in Ring 1, they will move to Ring 2 and follow the above show order. **The order of the show is subject to change.**

2. **CHECK IN:** Saturday before **8:00 AM**. The show will start with showmanship at **8:00 AM**.
3. **ANIMAL REGISTRATION:** The base date for computing the age of the does entered is July 21, 2018. All animals must be accompanied by registration, recordation or stamped ADGA duplicate application for animals under 6 months of age. All papers must be shown to the show secretary prior to show. No copies, telephone calls, or photos will be accepted in lieu of original papers.
4. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** Current health papers must accompany animals originating from your home state. All animals must be listed on an official AAI-13 Health Certificate. **ALL ANIMALS MUST BE CHECKED BEFORE UNLOADING. DO NOT UNLOAD UNTIL SHOW COMMITTEE OR VET CHECKS YOUR ANIMALS!** Animals showing signs of infectious or contagious disease (including soremouth pinkeye, abscesses, ringworm) will be barred from the show. The decision of the Show Committee and appointed Vet will be final.
5. **PEN FEES:** Instead of pen fees you are required to clean your own pens. If you do not want to clean your own pens, then a **\$10 per pen** fee will be charged. You only need to place bedding in the aisle. Note that the pens must be completely cleaned out! No refrigerators or cooking devices in the barns for fire safety reasons.
6. **ENTRY FEES:**  
PDGA members: Entries postmarked by July 10: \$8.00 double ring and \$4.00 single ring.  
Non-members: Entries postmarked by July 10: \$10.00 double ring and \$5.00 single ring.  
PDGA Members and Non-members: Entries postmarked after July 10 and day of show entries: \$14.00 double ring and \$7.00 single ring. There is no entry fee for the specialty show group classes which will be held for the Oberhasli and Saanen breeds.

7. **NO SMOKING:** No smoking allowed in or around Barn Area and Show Ring.  
**DOGS:** Dogs should be restrained and kept out of the goat barns and show ring.  
**BICYCLES:** No bicycles, roller blades or skateboards allowed in or around the Barn Area and Show Ring.
8. **FOOD:** A food booth will be provided by the Centre County 4-H Goat Club.
9. **EXCLUSION OF RESPONSIBILITY:** The PDGA and the Grange Encampment and Centre Country Fair Association will not be responsible for any accidents or loss to persons, property, or animals while on the fairgrounds.
10. **RV CAMPERS: \$30 per night (payable to PDGA)**

- Junior Get of Sire: 3 junior does out of same sire (identify the sire above)
- Best 3 Junior Does: 3 junior does owned by the same exhibitor\*
- Senior Get of Sire: 3 senior does out of same sire (identify the sire above)
- Produce of Dam: 2 does from the same dam (at least one has to be in milk)
- Dam & Daughter: Both does must be in milk
- Dairy Herd: 3 does in milk owned by the same exhibitor\*

\* Classes which require the same exhibitor to own all of the does
