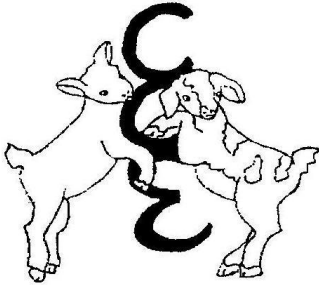

Directions: The State Show will be held at the Centre County Fairgrounds in Centre Hall. Centre Hall is located approximately 12 miles from State College, PA on Route 144. The fairgrounds are located in the center of town. Watch for Grange Fair entrance signs. Use gates 2 and 3.

Class Sponsors and Raffle Table Items - Appreciated!

1. **SHOW ORDER** . . . This show is sanctioned by ADGA and their rules shall govern. The Junior and Senior Doe shows **are** separately sanctioned. Sr. Doe show starts at 8:00 Saturday & Sunday with Jr. Doe Show to follow. **Show Order:** Alpines, LaManchas, Nigerian Dwarfs, Nubians, Oberhasli, Toggenburgs, AOP & Recorded Grades.
The show committee has the right to change the show order if they see fit.
2. **YOUTH SHOW** This show is a COMBINED DOE SHOW sanctioned by ADGA and their rules shall govern. Youth show will be on **Friday, July 16th @ 1:00 PM**. Show order will be: Showmanship then Alpine, Nubian, All Other Purebreds, & Recorded Grade. Youth Show animals **must** be owned by a youth as stated on registration certificate, and must be shown by a Youth. Age determined as of January 1st.
3. **Buck Show** is ADGA sanctioned show and their rules shall govern. Show starts at 7pm Friday. **Show Order:** Nubian, AOP and Nigerian Dwarf.
4. **ANIMAL REGISTRATION** Base date of animals is to be the day the animals are shown. The original registration certificate is required for all animals over 6 months. Animals under 6 months must have stamped duplicate application, stamped duplicate fax or registration certificate. All papers must be shown to show secretary prior to show. No copies, telephone calls or telegrams will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.
5. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS** Current health papers must accompany animals originating from your home state. All animals must be listed on an official AAI-13 Health Certificate. **ALL ANIMALS MUST BE CHECKED BEFORE UNLOADING. DO NOT UNLOAD UNTIL SHOW COMMITTEE OR VET CHECKS YOUR ANIMALS!** Any animals showing signs of infectious or contagious disease (soremouth, pinkeye, abscesses, ringworm) but not limited to will be barred from the show. No natural horned animals to be shown. The decision of the Show Committee and appointed Vet will be final.
6. **CHECK IN:** Sat. & Sun. check in by **7:45 AM**. Friday- Youth check in by **12:45 PM**. Buck check in by 6:45PM
7. **ENTRY FEES** **Youth show** per animal will be \$3.50 or \$3.00 for PDGA member. **PDGA Open Doe** show pre-registration per \$4.50 for one ring; \$7.50 for two rings with a .50 discount for PDGA members. Buck Show Entry Fee \$ /buck. **All pre-registered entries** must be postmarked by July 10, 2010. Entries postmarked after July 10th and the day of show will be \$10.00 per head per ring. There will be a \$2.00 entry fee for Miss Pa accepted until time of judging. (See rules on following page). **Send all entry fees to Show Secretary:** Cindy Puff, 140 Puff Lane, Centre Hall PA 16828. Make checks payable to PDGA, WPDGA or CCE according to entry form. Return check charge \$50.00. No entry refunds for any reason.

8. **PENS**..... Pens will be available on a first come first served basis. The cost is \$1.00 per pen. There will be a flat \$5.00 fee for showing out of your trailer. We apologize for these fees but due to the rise in our fairgrounds rent, we are forced to charge these fees.
9. **ELECTRIC HOOK UP**..... \$20.00 per night payable to show secretary.
10. **NO SMOKING** No smoking allowed in or around Barn Area and Show Ring.
11. **DOGS** Dogs should be restrained and kept out of the goat barns and show ring.
12. **FOOD** . . .
13. **EXCLUSION OF RESPONSIBILITY:** PDGA, CCE or WPDGA will not be responsible for any accidents or loss to persons, property, or animals while on the fairgrounds.
14. **BICYCLES**...No bicycles, roller blades or skateboards allowed in or around Barn Area and Show Ring.

1. ADULT & YOUTH JUDGING - Friday July 16th, 2010

Judge – Todd Biddle– Judge along during the Youth Show

- Classes:
1. Age up to 14 years
 2. Ages 15 - 21
 3. Age 22 and Up - Adults

All participants will judge two or three classes of goats (depending on availability of animals). Ribbons will be awarded.

2. PDGA YOUTH REP. CONTEST – Saturday July 16th, 2010

If you are sixteen or older, please check when you arrive at the show for all the details and responsibilities of competing for this title.

3. PREMIER EXHIBITOR POINT SYSTEM

Please note that you must declare at the time of entry, which family members will be included as one exhibitor with same herd name and all animals must reside, on one property. Partnership animals are considered owned by a separate exhibitor. The Grand Champion can only hold his or her points for the day or the Champion Challenge points whichever is higher. If there are no Challengers, the Grand Champion will receive the first place Champion challenge points. Only the exhibitors top 20 placings for the weekend excluding Friday's Youth Show, Example: If 7 animals are shown in all three rings your top 20 placings would be counted. Awards will be presented at the Fall meting.

4. PDGA OUTSTANDING YOUTH AWARDS

PDGA is going to be offering an OUTSTANDING YOUTH AWARD for both the Junior and senior youth based on participation in all of the following categories.

1. Your percentage score based on 100 derived from the placement of each of 2 or 3 judging class of 4 animals each.
2. The placement of your top three dairy goats owned by you. The scoring will be 300 for 1st, 280 for 2nd, 250 for 3rd, 240 for a 4th, and 220 for 5th place.
3. A dairy goat show and management test worth a total of 300 points.
4. Your placement in the showmanship class: 300 for 1st, 280 for 2nd, 260 for 3rd, 240 for 4th, 220 for 5th, and all others get 200.
5. Your placement as part of a group of 3 in a fitting competition scored the same way as the youth competition at the National Show with 30 minutes to completely fit an animal. Scoring 300 for 1st, 280 for 2nd, 260 for 3rd, 240 for 4th, 220 for 5th and all other groups 200. **It will be your responsibility to supply the goat and equipment for the clipping competition.**
